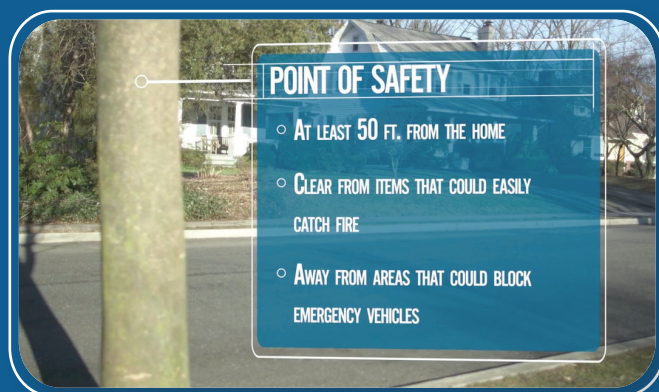

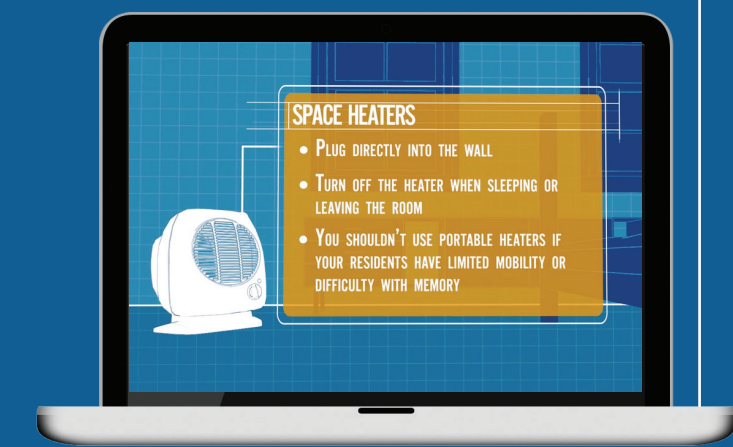


Designed by experts in safety and disaster planning with FEMA funding, this 20-minute video provides guidance to prevent and respond to emergencies.
